CANPRO ON ASSIGNMENT AROUND THE GLOBE

SOUTH EAST ASIA

Internationally, Canpro Training Resources continues to work with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) developing national training models for justice officials in South East Asia. The focus of the training relates to investigating incidents of commercial sexual exploitation and trafficking of children, and how police and other justice officials can conduct these investigations in a manner consistent with international human rights standards and norms. Canpro instructors have been doing this kind of work in two SE Asian countries for four years now.

SUDAN

At the same time, Canpro Training Resources is working with the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) to help develop national justice capacity in Southern Sudan, which has just emerged from thirty years of civil war. In this project, Canpro is also working with the International Centre for Criminal Law Reform and Criminal Justice Policy, a UN affiliate centre. Canpro staff have made a total of seven trips throughout Southern Sudan in the past two years as a part of this project. Work focuses on the development of training materials, trainers, policy, procedures and institutional capacity, all in support of human rights development.

UAE

On behalf of the Ministry of Interior, United Arab Emirates, and through our UAE partner the National Security Institute, Canpro is providing research and technical expertise in relation to a UN resolution proposing an examination of international best practices in the regulation of private security companies, and their role in crime prevention. Canpro has been asked to prepare discussion materials for the January UN expert group meeting in Abu Dhabi.

IRAQ & AFGHANISTAN

Our operations in Iraq and new office in Kabul, Afghanistan focus on enhancing public security and human safety through the delivery of comprehensive security consulting services, training and embedded security management.

KOLKATA [Calcutta]

Canpro GI Security's Kolkata training center is now operational. We recently opened our second facility in Delhi. Additional modern and well-equipped training institutes will be opening across the country in 2010.

Companies Vulnerable to Layoff Revenge

"The current economic environment puts companies at a higher risk for technology threats from newly laid-off workers, and the situation is exacerbated by a lack of resources available to put in place safeguards", a report said November 9th.

An annual information-security survey by Ernst & Young, a global business advisory firm, showed **75% of companies are concerned** about former employees participating in some kind of technology-related sabotage against them.

As well, **41% reported an increase in external attacks** recently.

Claude Francoeur, a partner in Ernst & Young's IT risk practice, said some of the common offences penetrated by ex-workers include disrupting workplace systems, tampering with websites and stealing information.

"Former employees have the ability - certainly with prior access & knowledge - to conduct those attacks," he said.

Francoeur advised firms to disable people's access to corporate networks immediately upon their termination.

Economic Crime Rate Rises in Canada

In its annual survey of Canadian companies, PricewaterhouseCoopers found economic crime is pervasive, persistent and pernicious. For instance the survey showed:

56% of Canadian companies surveyed reported falling prey to white-collar crime in the past 12 months.

83% of economic crime victims reported asset misappropriation as their most common type of fraud followed by accounting fraud and money laundering at 31 & 28 percent respectively.

38% of victims detected their fraud by chance or through an internal or external tip-off.

During difficult economic times, the incentive to commit fraud increases while the focus on detection, prevention and investigation diminishes.

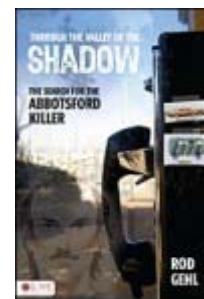
Headquartered in Vancouver, Rod will be managing high-level criminal and civil investigations for Canpro's corporate clients and their legal counsel in western Canada and abroad.

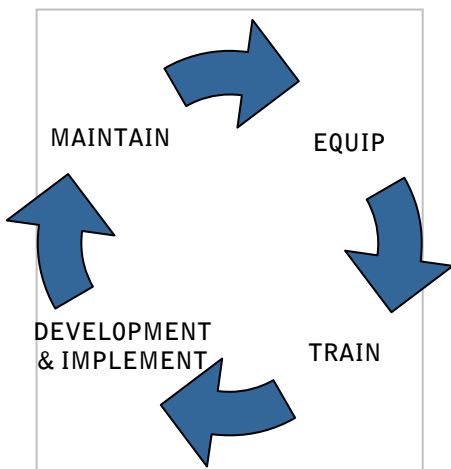
